BACKGROUND:

The Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (District) licenses CodePal software for managing permitting, building plans, and inspection processes in the District's Fire Prevention Bureau. The District entered into a Software and Services Agreement with Sybatech Inc. to review and refresh the District's CodePal database, install a public-facing web interface, and other related work for the period January 1, 2015, through December 31, 2018. Capitol Strategies Consulting, Inc. has acquired CodePal software, and Sybatech, Inc. transferred all CodePal related contracts and work to Capital Strategies Consulting, Inc. An Assignment, Assumption, and Consent will allow the District to continue to receive the
