RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Director of Child Support Services, or designee, to execute an Interagency Agreement with Merced County Department of Child Support Services, a government agency, to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$120,000, to provide Early Intervention Services for the period of October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:


Approval of this Interagency Agreement will result in a total payment to the County, not to exceed \$120,000 during the term of the agreement. No County matching funds required.

BACKGROUND:

The California State Department of Child Support Services has issued a statewide mandate for local child support agencies to focus on early intervention efforts to prevent payment delinquency and increase collections. The Department of Child Support Services has a contract with Maximus Human Services, Inc. to provide early intervention services. The pricing structure in the County's contract with Maximus includes discounts based on the volume of cases. Merced County Department of Child Support Services has requested to
