Subject: Appropriation Adjustment - Office of the Sheriff Delta Station

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE Appropriations and Revenue Adjustment No. 5036 authorizing new revenue in the amount of \$75,000 from CSA P-6 Zone funding and appropriating it into the Plant Acquisition-Sheriff account (0111/4407) to partially fund the relocation of the Sheriff's Office - Delta Patrol station from the old Oakley Library to the Brentwood Police Department.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This action increases revenues and appropriations by \$75,000. There is no impact on the County General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Office of the Sheriff's Delta Patrol station is currently housed in the old Oakley Library. This patrol station is inadequate for our needs, as it is in a state of disrepair and not centrally located for deployment. Moving Sheriff's Office personnel to the Brentwood Police Department building will provide a modern, clean and professional work environment that is ideally located for service to all East County
