RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #27-704-5 with Diablo Dialysis Access Center, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000, to provide dialysis access services for the period from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Contra Costa Health Plan Enterprise Fund II. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On January 6, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-704-4 with Diablo Dialysis Access Center, A California Professional Medical Corporation, for the provision of dialysis access services, for the period from December 1, 2014 through November 30, 2016. Approval of Contract #27-704-5 will allow Contractor to continue providing dialysis access services through November 30, 2018.
