RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-429-25 with Jackson & Coker Locum Tenens, LLC, a limited liability company, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, for the provision of temporary help physicians at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC) and the County's Main Detention Facility, for the period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On January 19, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-429-24 with Jackson & Coker Locum Tenens, LLC, for the period from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, for the provision of temporary physicians to cover vacation, sick leave, and extended leave relief for County-employed physicians at CCRMC and County's Main Detention Facility. Approval of Contract #26-429-25 will allow the Contractor to continue to provide temporary physicians through December 31, 2017. The contract contains modifications to
