BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Bureau has identified a specific type of professional development training, Reflective Supervision, that will assist the childcare program supervisors to better serve the population. UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital has a training unit in the Early Intervention Program services, that are a good match for CSB. The board approved the establishment of a contract containing mutual indemnification language with UCSF Benioff to provide a 3-day training services to well equip the childcare program services in the practice of Reflective Supervision on November 1, 2016 (c.43).
