## FISCAL IMPACT:

Upon approval, the Department may incur contractual expenses of up to \$102,600 during the proposed contract period, which would be funded 100% by County Patch Program funds.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The County's Patch Program provides residential board and care for post medical, surgical and/or custodial care patients who have been discharged from CCRMC and would otherwise not have appropriate follow up care. On April 26, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #76-537 with Vivian Price, for the provision of residential board and care services for CCRMC patients in the Patch Program for the period from April 1, 2016
