Subject: Agreement with the State of California for law enforcement services at the County Fair

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to execute a contract with the State of California, 23rd District Agricultural Association, including full indemnification of the State of California, to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$32,500 to provide law enforcement services at the Contra Costa County Fair for the period May 17, 2017 through May 21, 2017.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

\$32,500; 100% State of California reimbursement revenue.

**BACKGROUND:**

Each year the State of California provides funding to the Office of the Sheriff to provide law enforcement services at the County Fair. This contract will enable the Sheriff's Office to augment regular deputies with reserve deputies during the event at no cost to the County.

**CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

The Sheriff's Office will not be authorized to enter into the contract.
