Subject: Amendment #22-953-2 with California Immunization Coalition

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #22-953-2 with California Immunization Coalition, a non-profit corporation, effective March 1, 2017, to amend Contract #22-953-1, to increase the payment limit by \$30,974, from \$419,040 to a new payment limit of \$450,014, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Upon approval, the Department may incur additional contractual expenses of up to \$30,974 during the proposed agreement period, which would be funded 100% by the State Immunization Grant. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On December 10, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #22-953-1 with California Immunization Coalition for the provision of promotion and education with regard to the California Immunization Registry (CAIR), including public-private collaboration in the development of CAIR, informing and educating healthcare providers and their communities on emerging immunization issues and new vaccine recommendations, and
