RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #24-680-32 with Telecare Corporation, a corporation, effective April 1, 2017, to amend Contract #24-680-31, to increase the payment limit by \$575,000, from \$1,352,909 to a new payment limit of \$1,927,909, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 81% Mental Health Realignment; 19% Hospital Utilization Review. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On November 1, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #24-680-31 with Telecare Corporation for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, for the provision of mental health gero-psychiatric services and sub-acute care for Severely and Persistently Mentally III patients.
