Subject: Amendment #74-317-13 with Alternative Family Services, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #74-317-13 with Alternative Family Services, Inc., a non-profit corporation, effective April 1, 2017, to amend Novation Contract #74-317-12, to increase the payment limit by \$231,978, from \$744,110 to a new payment limit of \$976,088, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, and to increase the automatic extension payment limit by \$115,989, from \$372,055 to a new payment limit of \$488,044 through December 31, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Amendment is funded 50% Federal Financial Participation; 50% Mental Health Realignment. (No Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On June 21, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74-317-12 with Alternative Family Services, Inc., for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2017, for the provision of Multidimensional Treatment Foster Care (MTFC) services to Seriously

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Approval of Contract Amendment Agreement #74-317-13 will allow the Contractor to provide additional MTFC services through June 30, 2017.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this amendment is not approved, seriously emotionally disturbed children and their families will not have access to Contractor's additional mental health services.

CHILDREN'S IMPACT STATEMENT:
