RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #27-253-13 with California Eye Clinic, a partnership, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000, to provide ophthalmology, optometry and ambulatory surgery center services for Contra Costa Health Plan members and County recipients for the period from May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Contra Costa Health Plan Enterprise Fund II. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On April 21, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-253-11 (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreement #27-253-12) with California Eye Clinic, a partnership, for the period from May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2017 to provide ophthalmology and optometry services to Contra Costa Health Plan members and County recipients.
