Subject: Amendment #26-911-25 with Thomas B. Hargrave, M.D.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-911-25 with Thomas B. Hargrave, M.D., an individual, effective March 16, 2017, to amend Contract #26-911-24, to increase the payment limit by \$136,000, from \$342,000 to a new payment limit of \$478,000, with no change in the original term of September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On September 23, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-911-24 with Thomas B. Hargrave, M.D., for the provision of gastroenterology services including, but not limited to: consultation, training, on-call coverage services and medical procedures at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC), for the period from September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2017.
