# **BACKGROUND:**

The certification review hearing officer conducts these hearings, which are mandated by law. On July 7, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-099-13 with John Dawdy, Esq., for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017, to sit as the certification review hearing officer for patients involuntarily
