## RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to execute a contract with the Contra Costa Community College District, including mutual indemnification, to pay the County an amount not to exceed $\$ 40,000$ to provide police dispatching services for the period June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2022.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

No net County cost. $\$ 40,000$ revenue over five years.

## BACKGROUND:

The Office of the Sheriff will provide police dispatching services, limited to law enforcement activity for the Contra Costa Community College District. Services will include dispatching, call-taking, sending and receiving voice and data traffic, answering emergency (911) calls and warrent checks to aid the College District's Police Department.

## CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Failure to approve this contract will result in the inability of the Sheriff's Office to provide the Contra Costa Community College District with adequate 911 Dispatcher ServicesOTHER
