### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #22–137–51, with Meals on Wheels and Senior Outreach Services, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$376,637, to provide home-delivered meals for the Senior Nutrition Program, for the period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. This Contract includes a three-month automatic extension through September 30, 2018, in an amount not to exceed \$94,159.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is 100% federally funded under Title III-C2 of the Older Americans Act of 1965. (Rate increase)

### **BACKGROUND:**

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing home-delivered meals on 250 serving days, to an average of 830 senior citizens, to ensure they receive at least one-third of their daily nutritional requirements. On June 14, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #22-137-50 with Meals on Wheels and Senior Outreach Services of Contra Costa, for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017,

# BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

a three-month automatic extension through September 30, 2017, for the provision of home-delivered meals for the Senior Nutrition Program. Approval of Novation Contract #22-137-51 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract and allows the Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2018, including modifications to County's Standard Indemnification and Confidentiality clauses.

## CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, County's homebound senior citizens will not receive Senior Nutrition Program meals, which provide at least one third of their daily nutrition.
