BACKGROUND:

Due to retirements and an employee on long term leave, additional temporary staff is needed to handle claims in a timely manner and avoid penalties for delayed payments due to inadequate staffing. Essential Staffing has the highly experienced staff needed to fill the vacant positions immediately.
