RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #74-341-99(3) with Hugo Gonzales, MFT, an individual, effective July 1, 2017, to increase the payment limit by \$85,000, from \$200,000 to a new payment limit of \$285,000, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded by 50% Federal Medi-Cal and 50% State Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

In November 2016, the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed, Contract #74-341-99(2) with Hugo Gonzales, MFT, for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018, for the provision of Medi-Cal specialty mental health services.

At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization.
