Subject: 2017-18 Fairgrounds Center Childcare Services Operation

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract including modified indemnification language with First Baptist Church of Pittsburg, California, in an amount not to exceed \$1,429,431 to provide childcare services at Fairgrounds Children's Center, for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

### BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Fairgrounds Children's Center, as a result of a Request for Proposal (RFP). First Baptist Church of Pittsburg was the successful respondent to the RFP. The first nine (9) months of the contract was approved by the Board on the above date, and the contract has been renewed annually since. This board order renews the contract for the 2017-18 program year.

Contra Costa County receives funds from the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) to provide Head Start program services to program eligible County residents. County also receives funds from the California Department of Education (CDE) Child Development program for State Preschool and General Childcare and Development program services. The State requires an indemnification clause with County subcontractors wherein the subcontractor holds harmless the State and its officers for any losses.

Approval of this board order allows the continued provision of the following services at Fairgrounds Children's Center, for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

### CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If not approved, County will not be able to more widely distribute childcare availability through partnership with community based agencies.

### CHILDREN'S IMPACT STATEMENT:
