Subject: Contract #26-661-8 with Planned Parenthood, Shasta Diablo, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-661-8 with Planned Parenthood, Shasta Diablo, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,214,000, for the provision of prenatal services for Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Health Centers patients, for the period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On August 9, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-661-7 with Planned Parenthood, Shasta Diablo, Inc. to provide, upon request of the County's Health Services Director or his designee, its licensed and certified personnel to perform prenatal services to Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Health Center (CCRMC) patients at County's leased clinic facilities located in Concord, Richmond and Antioch, for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Approval of Contract

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

#26-661-8 will allow Contractor to continue to provide prenatal services to CCRMC patients at County's leased clinic facilities located in Concord, Richmond and Antioch through June 30, 2018, including changes to County's standard indemnification language of the General Conditions.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved Contractor will be unable to provide services to a significant number of low income women in the county who would either be without services or directed to County health services sites.
