Subject: Contract #74-271-65(11) with Judith McIntyre, MFT

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #74-271-65(11) with Judith McIntyre, MFT, an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, to provide Medi-Cal specialty mental health services, for the period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded by 50% Federal Medi-Cal and 50% State Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On January 14, 1997, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution #97/17, authorizing the Health Services Director to contract with the State Department of Mental Health (now known as the Department of Health Care Services), to assume responsibility for Medi-Cal specialty mental health services. Responsibility for outpatient specialty mental health services involves contracts with individual, group and organizational providers to deliver these services.
