Subject: ADOPT Traffic Resolution No. 2017/4455 to prohibit vehicles over 40 feet in length on Pinehurst Road (Road No. 2631A)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

ADOPT Traffic Resolution No. 2017/4455 to prohibit vehicles over 40 feet in length on Pinehurst Road (Road No. 2631A), as recommended by the Public Works Director, Canyon area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND:

Pinehurst Road is a narrow canyon road with numerous vertical and horizontal curves, including two sharp hairpin turns nearer to the northern end. There have been 26 traffic collisions on this roadway since 2009, including four collisions involving bicyclists. We have been informed of larger trucks having been "stuck" on the hairpin turns, causing a nuisance and safety hazard. State-standard truck (WB-40) turning templates show that vehicles over 40 feet in length cannot negotiate the hairpin turns without encroaching into
