(dba Canyon Manor), a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$227,206, to provide mental health subacute care and treatment services for adults, for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Upon approval, this contract will result in expenditures of up to \$227,206 for mental health services, which will be funded 100% by Mental Health Realignment funding. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing long-term care for adults with serious mental illness who require skilled nursing inpatient psychiatric care.
