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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #26-536-12 with Jeffrey L. Stern, M.D., A Professional Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$345,000, to provide gynecology/oncology services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa Health Centers for the period October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2020.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Contract is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

**BACKGROUND:**

On September 21, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-536-11 with Jeffrey L. Stern, M.D., A Professional Corporation, for the provision of gynecology/oncology services at CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers including surgical procedures, pre-operative and post-operative care of patients with gynecological malignancy, on-call coverage and training, for the period October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2017.
