Subject: Contract #74-469-3 with Pathways to Wellness Medication Clinic

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute Contract #74-469-3 with Pathways to Wellness Medication Clinic, a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$230,308 to provide children's and adult mental health services for the period July 1, 2017 through October 31, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 50% Federal Medi-Cal and 50% County Realignment. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing a broad range of mental health services to children and adults in Central County. This contract is a part of the System of Care and contributes to the County's compliance with Mental Health regulations.

On January 17, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-469-2, with Pathways to Wellness Medication Clinic, for the period January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017 for the provision of children's and adult mental health services.
