## **BACKGROUND:**



Employees experienced extremely long waits to redeem their vouchers for testing and subsequent reading. In an effort to provide better services, MDUSD, Contra Costa Health Services, Public Health Clinic Services have coordinated services to provide TB testing and reading at one MDUSD facility.
