RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #74-419-8 with William E. Berlingieri, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$313,600, to provide outpatient psychiatric services in West Contra Costa County, for the period from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Services Act. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On December 6, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-419-6, (as amended by Amendment Agreement #74-419-7) with William E. Berlingieri, M.D, for the provision of outpatient psychiatric services to mentally ill adults in West Contra Costa County, including diagnosis, counseling, evaluation, medical and therapeutic treatment, consulting, and training in medical and therapeutic matters for the period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

Approval of Contract #74-419-8 will allow the contractor to continue providing outpatient
