Subject: Approve a Purchase Order Amendment with Lehr Auto Electric, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute, on behalf of the Interim Public Works Director, a purchase order amendment with Lehr Auto Electric, Inc., to increase the payment limit by \$150,000 to a new payment limit of \$800,000, for emergency vehicle parts and accessories, with no change to the original term of February 1, 2016 through January 31, 2018, Countywide.



BACKGROUND:

Public Works Fleet Services purchases and outfits all emergency services vehicles for the County. This includes vehicles from the Sheriff, Public Works, Animal Services, Probation, District Attorney and Health Services. The Sheriff's vehicles take up the vast majority of this commodity. Outfitting includes lights, consoles, electrical switching, electronics, wiring, and other hard parts such as partitions, consoles and trunk slider trays. This commodity was originally bid on BidSync #1301-003 and awarded to Lehr Auto Electric,
