## **BACKGROUND:**

This started in the 2nd floor restrooms, and saturated sections of the first, second and the basement floors. Restoration Management was called out to abate the area and give us a quote on reconstruction of all damaged areas. The water remediation and reconstruction has been estimated at \$250,000.
