FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On November 17, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #23-441-4 with the DJR Healthcare Consulting, Inc. to provide professional management and oversight of the Department's IT Unit including, but not limited to, providing a qualified Chief Information Officer who will provide day to day on-site management, act as the technical expert with regard to all Health Services Department IT Systems, lead the IT Steering Committee, develop formal written strategic plans, policies and procedures, create processes for identifying system user needs and translate
