Subject: Amendment #23-532-4 with Asante Alliance, LLC

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #23-532-4 with Asante Alliance, LLC, a limited liability company, effective August 1, 2017, to amend Contract #23-532-3, to increase the payment limit by \$750,000, from \$100,000 to a new payment limit of \$850,000, with no change in the original term of December 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This amendment is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

**BACKGROUND:**

In December 2016, the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed Contract #23-532-3 with Asante Alliance, LLC for the provision of qualified consultants, contract-to-hire and/or direct placement candidates for hard to fill positions in the Health Services Department's Information Technology Unit for the period from December 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018.
