Subject: California State Parks, Division of Boating and Waterways

RECOMMENDATION(S):

ADOPT Resolution No. 2018/110 ratifying a Memorandum of Understanding entered into by the Sheriff-Coroner with the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways and approve and authorize the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to apply for and accept reimbursement funding for critical skills training from the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways with an initial request of \$25,000 for the period beginning June 5, 2017 through the end of reimbursement funding availability.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$25,000: 100% State. No in kind match.

BACKGROUND:

The California State Parks, Division of Boating and Waterways has set aside funding to assist local agencies with Maritime Officer training through the Maritime Law Enforcement Training Center. This Federal assistance is authorized by Chapter 131 of Title 46 of the United States Code for training personnel in skills related to boating safety and to the enforcement of boating safety laws and regulations. Division of Boating and Waterways will reimburse government agencies with federal monies for allowed transportation, lodging, and
