APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #76-607 with JBTatum Corporation, a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$108,000 for the provision of professional consultation, management, and technical assistance to the Materials Management Unit at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) for the period from May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this contract is 100% from Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

BACKGROUND:

Under Contract #76-607, the contractor will provide professional consultation, management, and technical assistance to the Materials Management Unit including managing employees and identifying cost savings for the period May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019. The contractor has previous experience in the Materials Management Unit and with the current Material Management Supervisor on leave, the unit believes the contractor will be able to assist in providing the needed administrative oversight and coordination of the procurement, storage, distribution and accounts payable function for the Contra Costa Regional Medical
