Subject: Correct April 17, 2018 Board Order Item #C.27 with East Bay Tire Company

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE clarification of board action of April 17, 2018, Item C.27, which authorized the Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute a purchase order amendment with East Bay Tire Company, to correct the payment limit, which should have increased the payment limit by \$170,000 to a new total of \$380,000, for continued purchase of tires and tire supplies, as recommended by the Public Works Director, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This cost is to be funded through Fleet Internal Service Fund.

BACKGROUND:

On April 17, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase order amendment with East Bay Tire Company, to add \$70,000 for a new total payment limit of \$280,000 for continued purchase of tires and tire supplies. The purpose of this board order is to correct an error in the total payment limit which should have read to add \$170,000 for a new total payment limit of \$380,000.
