Under Contract #76-613, the contractor will provide remote entry of physician medication orders for Martinez Detention Facility, including reviewing and entering all medication orders into the Customer's Pharmacy Information System, resolving all incomplete or questionable orders submitted by the County Pharmacist, providing clinical support to Detention facility staff and conducting daily briefings with the Director of Pharmacy, through April 30, 2020. This contract includes mutual indemnification.
