Estate of Thanh Huynh: Personal injury claim for auto accident in the amount of \$1,000,000. Decedent's estate claims decedent died in an automobile accident in Hercules because a sign had fallen off its pole.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

In Kee Kang: Property claim for damage to fence in the amount of \$500. Claimant alleges damage to his fence caused by a firefighter responding to a fire near claimant's residence in Concord.

JoAnn McPheeters: Property claim for earrings and necklace in the amount of \$6,000. Claimant alleges jewelry was not returned to her when she was released from jail.

Khlood Salah: Personal injury claim involving a child dependency case in the amount of \$10,000,000. Claimant alleges her child was improperly taken from her during dependency proceedings.
