FISCAL IMPACT:

This cost is to be funded through Facilities Services maintenance budget. (100% General Funds)

BACKGROUND:

Facilities Services has been tasked with several requests for large maintenance projects to County facilities. With an improved County budget and Facility Life Implementation Plan, the work orders have begun to increase significantly. The amount of work has surpassed Facilities' ability to conduct work in a timely manner with the current staff. Government Code Section 25358 authorizes the County to contract for maintenance and upkeep of
