Subject: Contract with Child Abuse Prevention Council

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Child Abuse Prevention Council, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,308,694 to provide child abuse prevention services for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The funds allocated for this contract are 68% State 2011 Realignment (\$889,911) and 32% County General Fund (\$418,782).

BACKGROUND:

Child Abuse Prevention Council will direct and coordinate ongoing activities aimed at mobilizing community resources and educating professionals and citizens to reduce the incidents of child abuse.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Valuable services to prevent child abuse will not be provided.
