Subject: Contract #26-573-7 with Dominic Ciotola (dba CPR Training Center)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #26-573-7 with Dominic Ciotola (dba CPR Training Center), a sole proprietor, in an amount not to exceed \$282,000 to provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) courses for selected Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Center staff for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On March 31, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-573-6 with Dominic Ciotola (dba CPR Training Center) to provide American Heart Association-approved CPR courses, including Basic Life Support, Advanced Cardiac Life Support and Advanced Pediatric Cardiac Life Support courses for CCRMC and Health Center staff for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018.

Approval of Contract #26-573-7 will allow the contractor to continue to provide CPR
