Jane Doe 1 and Jane Doe 2 – Personal injury claims in the amount of \$5,000,000 apiece alleging sexual assault by deputy sheriff while claimants were inmates in county jail. Enterprise Rent-A-Car Company of San Francisco

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

- Property claim for damage to vehicle in the amount of \$2,821.98. Rental car company claims a County employee rented one of its cars and damaged it.

Anne Hancock – Claim for punitive damages and refund of court fees in the amount of \$4350. Claimant alleges that the Contra Costa County Superior Court mishandled her probate matter.

Timothy Thompson-Cook – Personal injury claim by former employee alleging wrongful termination and whistle-blower retaliation causing emotional distress damages in excess of \$10,000.

Khlood Salah – Personal injury claim for emotional distress and attorney fees in the amount of \$10,000. Claimant alleges that misconduct by a County employee caused her child to be taken away from her in a dependency matter.

Yekaterina Ramirez – Request that Board of Supervisors accept a late claim. Claimant requests leave to file a late claim alleging that misconduct by a County employee caused her child to be taken away from her in a dependency matter.
