Subject: Appropriation Adjustment - Patrol Boat (California Division of Boating and Waterways Equipment Grant)

---

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE Appropriations and Revenue Adjustment No. 5076 authorizing new revenue in the Sheriff's Office (0255) in the amount of \$38,730 from the California Division of Boating and Waterways Boating Safety Equipment Grant and appropriating it for the Sheriff's Office purchase of a patrol boat.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Zero Net County Cost. \$38,730, 100% State funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

Resolution No. 2017/322 authorized the Office of the Sheriff to accept a grant from the California Division of Boating and Waterways. The grant will be used to purchase a Marine Aluminum "Mud/Jon Boat", which will be operated in waterways with extreme hazards likely to damage a typical patrol vessel. The California Delta is tidal and harbors hazards to navigation which cannot be seen under the water i.e. shoals, weeds/vegetation, trees, stumps, derelict vessels, and decrepit levees. Under extreme conditions the Delta can have 4 to 6 foot swells and wind gusts up to 60 knots.

The boat will be used for rescue missions in shallow or water areas that are difficult to get to
