Subject: APPOINT PATRICE GUILLORY TO THE COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATION SEAT ON THE
COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PARTNERSHIP

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPOINT Patrice Guillory to the Community Based Organizations seat on the Community Corrections Partnership with a term expiring on December 31, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND:

Each year, the Public Protection Committee reviews the membership of the Community Corrections Partnership and makes recommendations for appointment to non *ex-officio* seats to the Board of Supervisors. The Board has made these appointments on a calendar year basis. In October 2017, the Committee recommended appointments to the Board for 13 of the 14 seats and directed the Community Advisory Board to make a recommendation for appointment to the Community Based Organizations seat.

On May 23, 2018, the Public Protection Committee approved a recommendation of the Community Advisory Board to recommend the appointment of Patrice Guillory, of HealthRIGHT 360, to the full Board of Supervisors to a term ending on December 31,
