FISCAL IMPACT:


\$732,709. 100% State, no county match. The grant will fund salaries and benefits for Attorney, Senior Inspector, Legal Assistant, and small amounts of other staff time assigned to the program. Supplantation is prohibited.

BACKGROUND:

The State Legislature has determined that one of the significant factors driving up the cost of automobile insurance is fraud. While fraud is recognized as a growing problem across the country, California is an area of concerted criminal activity in insurance fraud. The Automobile Insurance Fraud Prosecution award is allocated from a trust fund financed by
