

## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 16, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #23-326-16 (as amended by Contract Amendment #23-326-17 and Contract Extension #23-326-18), with Aspira Technologies, Inc., for the provision of consultation and technical assistance to the Department's Information Systems Unit for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018.
