RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #27-945-2 with Contra Costa Infectious Disease Medical Group, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 to provide infectious disease services to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members for the period from August 1, 2018 through July 31, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Contra Costa Health Plan Enterprise Fund II. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On August 9, 2016 the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed Contract #27-945-1 with Contra Costa Infectious Disease Medical Group, Inc., to provide infectious disease services to CCHP members for the period August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2018.
