BACKGROUND:

On March 3, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #23-553-3, as amended by Amendment/Extension Agreement #23-553-4, with Aspira Technologies, Inc., for the provision of consultation and technical support to the Department's Information Systems Unit on information technology analytics, including overseeing day-to-day leadership and reporting responsibilities, for the period from December 1, 2014 through June 30, 2018.
