Subject: APPROVE a contract with Denalect, Inc.

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Denalect, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$350,000 to provide alarm monitoring services at County facilities during the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021, Countywide. (100% General Fund)

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This cost is to be funded through Facilities Services occupancy costs. (100% General Fund)

**BACKGROUND:**

Public Works Facilities Services is responsible for electronic system (alarm) monitoring in County buildings. Denalect, was identified as the County's standard for this type of monitoring, and all alarmed buildings now have Denalect equipment installed in them. Government Code Section 31000 authorizes the County to contract for special services for
