### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This contract is funded 50% by Federal Medi-Cal and 50% by Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

### **BACKGROUND:**

On August 1, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-448-5, as amended by Amendment Agreement #74-448-6, with Edward Lau, M.D., for the period from September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018, for the provision of outpatient psychiatric services for children, at the East County Children's Clinic.

Approval of Contract #74-448-7 will allow the contractor to continue providing outpatient psychiatric services through August 31, 2019.
