County to receive an amount not to exceed \$11,000 from Assistance League of Diablo Valley. (No County match)


### **BACKGROUND:**

ILSP will administer, through Volunteer and Emergency Services in Action (VESTIA), the Senior Year Living Expenses Scholarship Program to eligible foster youth on behalf of the Assistance League of Diablo
