RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-995-16 with George Lee, M.D., an individual, effective July 1, 2018, to amend Contract #26-995-14 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-995-15), to add anesthesiology services for the Labor and Delivery Unit and decrease the payment limit by \$145,000 from \$1,735,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,590,000, with no change in the original term of August 1, 2015 through July 31, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On September 15, 2015 the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-995-14 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-995-15) with George Lee, M.D. to provide anesthesiology services including consultation, training, administrative services, medical procedures, on-call coverage, and coverage for the General, Obstetrics, Intensive Care and Radiology Units at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa
